Since 1995 the Kingfishers Bridge Nature Reserve has transformed over 250 acres of farmland into a mosaic of wildlife habitats.

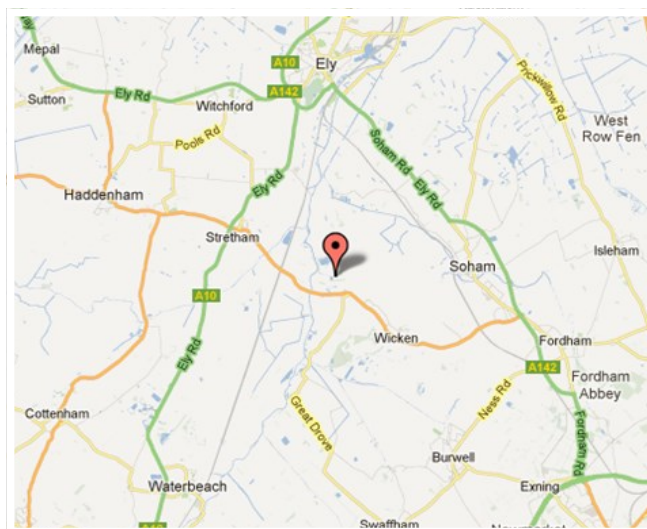
Based around our classroom or woodland camp, we can offer educational experiences for children from pre-school to sixth form or college.

Outdoor Learning 2022/2023



Kingfishers Bridge provides space and expertise for practical science, offering different habitats including ponds, woodland and meadowland.

Some of the activities we can cover include:

- pond dipping
- owl pellet dissection
- sweep netting
- transect surveying
- data collection
- analysing cause and effect
- compass work
- willow weaving

Visits can be linked to the National Curriculum or tailored to cover several subjects or activities including Science, Geography, and Art.

We can adapt education sessions to suit home education groups and youth groups.

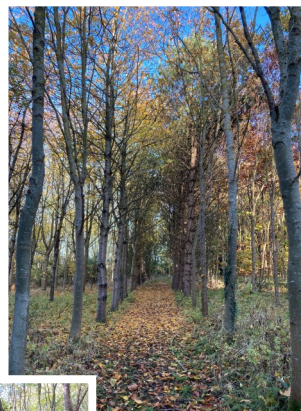


The sessions will be tailored to fit the age and varying abilities within your group.

All our activities are risk assessed and staff are DBS checked.

Whilst paths around the Reserve are wide and mostly flat, there is very little surfaced area. Every effort will be made to make all activities accessible, but please contact us if any of your party are wheelchair users or have mobility issues.

While some sessions can be moved to the classroom during inclement weather, some activities will have to be outdoors.
